Our version is told as an animated storytelling experience using simple paper puppets to bring the story to life.



The story is performed in a purpose built Russian style stage and lasts approximately 45 minutes.

Technical and power requirements.

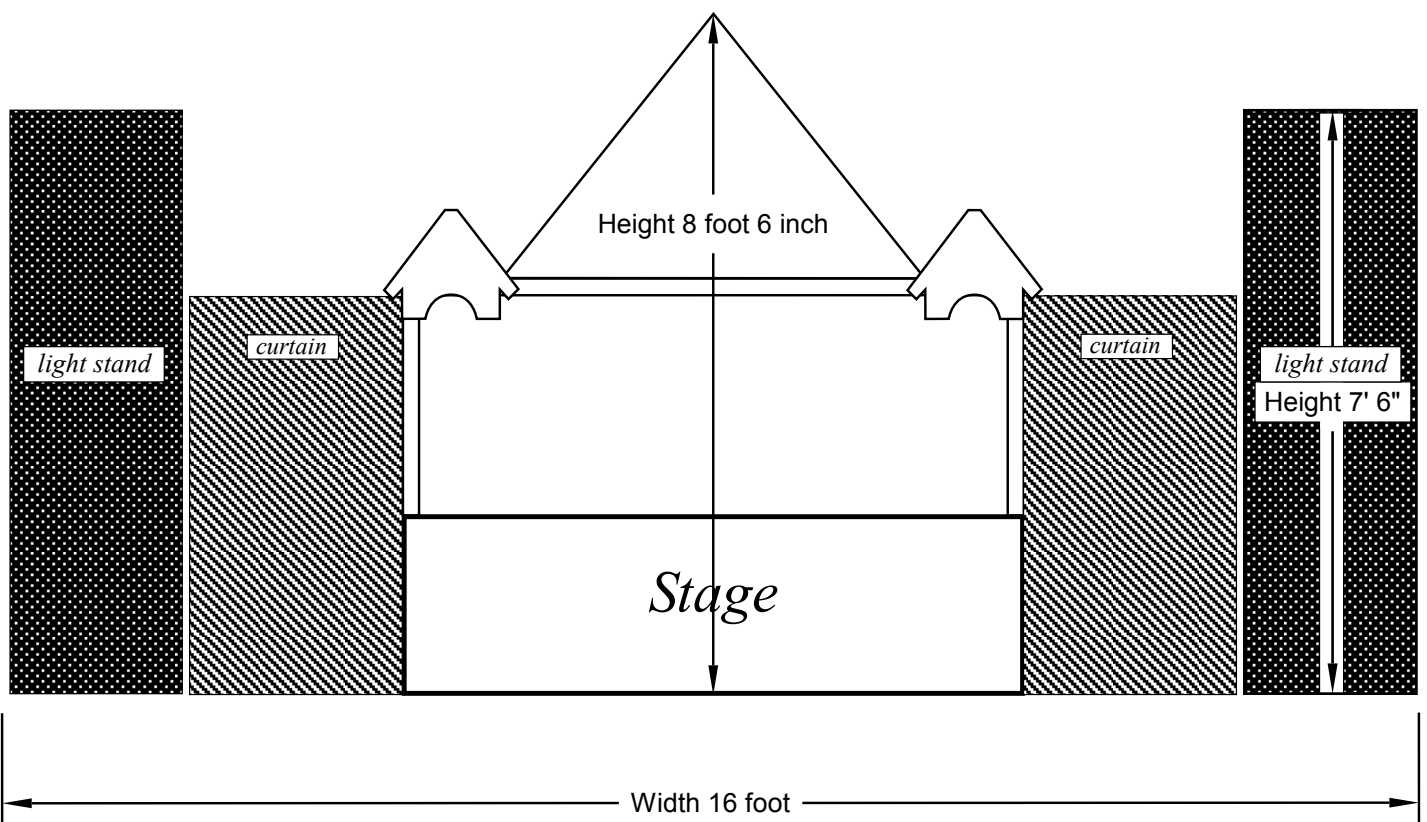
Two 13amp power points to the rear of the Backstage area.
